- Worked with a large team of multidisciplinary developers (FE/BE/Android/iOS) to coordinate simultaneous product and feature launches across separate codebases on tight timetables. Frequently shared out to other teams to resolve short-staffing and challenging development problems.
- Worked primarily in high-priority, mission-critical areas (login system, onboarding of new users, user activity feeds) and completed large refactors of these systems, greatly improving code quality and maintainability.
- Wrote Jest and Selenium unit tests for my own code, as well as the code of other developers.
- Participated in establishing and documenting new code standards, for my team and others, culminating in a new division-wide style guide.

- Worked closely with a small team of skilled developers and producers in an Agile arrangement on a day-to-day basis.
- Learned and implemented a wide variety of accessibility/ARIA technologies; created and modified components to utilize screen readers, high contrast modes, etc., in an intuitive way, including mobile variants (Apple VoiceOver on iOS devices, etc.)
- Coordinated with other teams to introduce complex features requiring external APIs and multi-part simultaneous launches of both client and server architectures.
- Conducted interviews for senior-level positions and below.
- Learned and operated the SiteMuse CDN platform; handled standardization and merging of all CSS additions to the site's core stylesheets.
- Greatly expanded knowledge of mobile development and platform-specific challenges; used this knowledge to develop complex web applications that function correctly on all modern smartphones.

- Hired as a junior dev; trusted to conduct senior-level interviews within just three months, after aiding in the success of Microsoft's Xbox E3 event hub.
- Led the team working on the Microsoft Devices event hub – the only web team out of six at HCL that launched with zero post-launch problems that day.
- Lead developer of internal tool “FastComp”, a browser-based tool for building and editing exportable previews of web pages, to augment design and copy-editing conversations with real in-browser previews at various resolutions.
- Conceptualized and programmed the internal “Real-Time News” content management system, allowing truly real-time posting of highlights and announcements in the form of small news cards to Microsoft websites. Used on the Xbox E3 hub, used again for the Devices event hub.
- Wrote the server environment and mirroring servers for the Real-Time News CMS, serving over 300,000 concurrent users during the Devices launch.
- Frequently and specifically called out by members of partner teams (at other companies) as helpful, clear, and productive, especially when the work required extensive collaboration. Requested by name for future collaborations multiple times.
- Managed several Azure services and virtual machines, including both Windows Server and Linux VMs; became proficient with Azure in general.
- Called for new code standards to remedy developer disorganization and enable the easy sharing of components between websites; my suggestions helped form the backbone of HCL's new code standards and educational materials for new employees.
